According to Cherokee County Emergency Management Agency (EMA) most tornadoes occur in Georgia from March through May. April is the peak month, although tornadoes can happen anytime of the year. WP residents have several ways of receiving severe weather warnings.

Architectural Committee Update

If you plan to add a structure including a fence, change the exterior of your

home or lot, or the use of your lot, you must submit plans to the Architectural Committee (AC) for approval.

Plans must include dimensions of the project, its location on the lot and materials and colors to be

used. A letter explaining your plans is needed. See the Architectural Guide, available on the website, for more information.

The covenants give the AC up to 60 days to review plans; however, reviews

are currently taking about two weeks from the time the AC receives useable

plans. Decisions require a majority vote of the AC.

Please give your plans to Hamp at 613 Ashley Trail or e-mail them to the address in the box.

In addition to AC approval, projects should comply with any applica-

ble county ordinances and zoning regulations and may require county permits.

1290 AM and Adelphia Channel 4. But you have to be awake and listening to the right station to hear a warning.

There are a couple of "automatic" warning systems available:

Sirens

Cherokee County has a network of warning sirens. These are activated by EMA when a tornado warning has been issued or a tornado sighted.

Siren locations within earshot of WP include:

- Hickory Road at New Light Road
- Toonigh Road east of Ranchwood Trail

Although the sirens can be heard indoors, they are designed to warn people outside. They may not wake you during the night.

These sirens are tested on the first Wednesday of each month.

Weather Alert Radio

Your best bet is one of the Specific Area Message Encoding (SAME) weather alert radios. The SAME feature allows you to program codes for specific counties. You don't hear warnings and watches that cover distant areas.

You won't sleep through this alarm when it sounds.

SAME capable radios can be purchased at \$50-70.

Cheaper weather alert radios without the SAME feature are available but you'll soon tire of being waked for warnings that apply to counties south of Atlanta. .


