The Property Tax Guide For The Georgia Taxpayer says "Georgia law provides a procedure for property tax appeals at the county level. Taxpayers may challenge an assessment by the county board of tax assessors by appealing to the county board of equalization or to an arbitrator or arbitrators.

Appeals may be filed on issues concerning:

- taxability the property is exempt from taxation,
- uniformity of assessment - values are the same within the same class of property,
- value if the county board of tax assessors changed the appraised value of the owner's property this year, and
- denials of homestead exemption."


