Pool Vandalism

After 11:00 p.m. on July 19, two Waverly Park teenagers were shown on the pool security video throwing a soccer-type ball at two of the



pool security cameras. After several attempts the cameras were hit and knocked out of alignment.

The homeowners responsible for the two teenagers conduct will be billed for restoring the cameras to operation.

The video also served to document several violations of pool rules.

As a result of the vandalism

and the rules violations, the WPHA Board of Directors has suspended the responsible homeowners right of use for the Common Area and pool as provided in the WPHA Covenants. The suspension is for 60 days ending on September 29 and extends to all family members of the homeowners.

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Common Area Rules Highlighted

Although the vast majority of Waverly Park residents are observing the published Common Area Rules, the violations that came to light as a result of the recent vandalism at the pool (See Pool Vandalism above.) suggests a need to highlight some of the rules.

Common Area Rules are in Board of Directors Resolution 2005-02, available on the WPHA website Documents page.

Here are excerpts:

- 2. Residents must escort their quests.
- 3. The Common Area is open daily from 7:00 a. m. until 11:00 p. m. Any person in the Common Area outside

these hours without permission from the Board of Directors is trespassing.

- 5. Responsible, older person(s) must supervise young children at all times. Other rules apply to the supervision of children in the pool area.
- 14. Only residents and a maximum of four (4) guests per household, escorted by residents, are allowed in the pool area.
- 15. Residents 18 years or older may bring guests to the pool.
- 16. Residents are responsible for the conduct of their guests and must see that the rules are obeyed and that others are not incon-

venienced.


- 17. Children under 14 must be accompanied by an adult 18 years or older at all times.
- 18. No one 18 years old and under allowed in the pool area after dark unless supervised by an adult 21 years old or older.
- 19. No one is allowed in the pool area without a key to the gate. The gate should not be opened for persons without a key.
