Two By-Laws amendments were also approved.

One amendment allows for single signatures on checks to the electric,

phone, water and pool maintenance providers. Two signatures are still required for other payments and reimbursements to individuals.

The second approved amendment sets the maximum number of directors at five. The minimum number is three.
