Countywide Burn Ban Begins May 1

--Cherokee County Emergency Services Press Release 5/1/09

"May 1st begins this year's ozone season, and with that comes a ban on open burning for residents of Cherokee County until September 30th, 2009.

Cherokee County is one of several counties in metro Atlanta affected by this ban. Types of open burning that are restricted in Cherokee County include:

- Burning of leaves, tree limbs or other yard waste
- Burning of forest land by property owners
- Burning of vegetative waste from land clearing (includes a ban on the use of air curtain destructors).

Fires for carrying out recognized agricultural practices, recreations purposes, cooking food or for training firefighting personnel are still allowed, provided there are no local ordinances which prohibit them.

Cherokee County residents needing burn permits for agricultural purposes need to contact Georgia Forestry by calling their on-line 1-877-OK2-BURN. The phone system informs callers by county whether or not they can burn.

Residents may also call their county GFC office for more information or visit GaTrees.org."
