But isn't there a pending project to widen (again) the Sixes Road bridge over I-575?

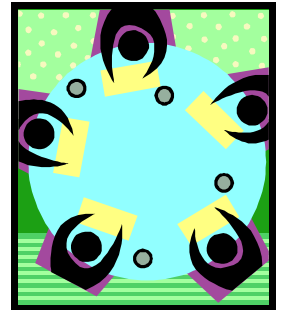

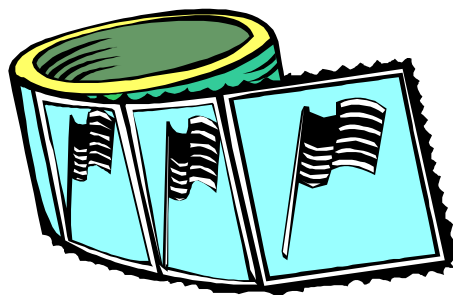
## Post Office Closings
