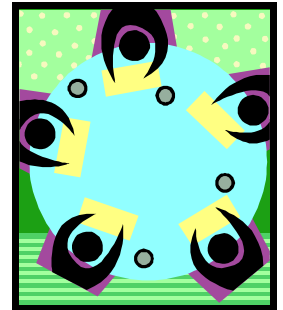

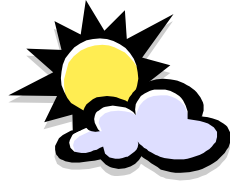
Sunshine Committee
