The AC is now sending project approval letters and other actions via email to homeowners who have an email address on file with WPP. The letters require the free Adobe Reader to open. • **Outdoor Burning OK with Daily Permit:** Outdoor burning of "Hand Piled Natural Vegetation" with a permit is now OK. Get a daily permit:

Call: 1-877-0K2-BURN.

"Fires should not be initiated before 8:00 a.m. and should be completely extinguished before dark." -GFC

Please consider wind direction and your neighbor's open windows before burning.

• Holly Springs Growth Boundary Agreement: The agreement between Holly Springs and Cherokee County calls for Holly Springs to limit expansion to certain boundaries (to the other side of Toonigh Road, for example.) Read the agreement at:
