The WPHA Board of Directors (BOD) has recently suspended the pool privileges of two homeowners for 30 days each for violating our rules:

- Allowing under aged children to use the pool unsupervised by a responsible adult.
- After hours pool access

The BOD reminds homeowners and residents of our rules covering the Common Area (pool, playground, walking trail and parking lot). Click here to view our rules. These rules are in place to insure all WP residents can safely enjoy use of the Common Area and in many cases are simply repeating parts of the county's swimming pool ordinance. They also help reduce WPHA's liability stemming for any problems on the Common Area.

Please note:

- Common Area hours are 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. No one should be present outside these hours.
- Children 15 years old and under must at all times be supervised by a responsible adult 18 years of age or older who has specifically agreed to supervise the under aged children.
- Anyone opening the gate for people who arrive without a key card is assuming responsibility for the conduct of those people.
- Pets are not allowed inside the pool fence.

All homeowners have an interest (that liability mentioned earlier) in helping to enforce our rules. If you see a problem, say something.
